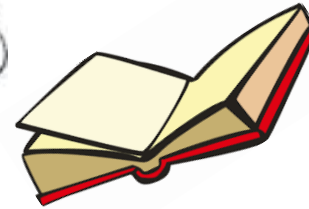

- Share your work in a way that educates others about MOM and your specific topic
- Use your project as a teaching tool or other interactive platform
- This internship could also potentially include editing the Journal of Mother Studies (JourMS)

Learning Goals:

- Become familiar with the social, cultural, and public health issues families face
- Learn about mothers, fathers, and families from an interdisciplinary perspective
- Practice using resource materials
- Practice conducting interviews
- Engage with new online tools and/or other informational resources
- Gain insight into some of the ways research can be employed to educate
- Intersect in meaningful ways with the general public with your project
- Develop editorial skills

Time Commitment: 5-20 hours per week

Requirements: Students should like individualized projects and be eager to conduct research. Some writing skills and an ability to finalize a project are essential.
